If an agent or the holder of a power of attorney is signing a document, required to be lodged by an Act, on behalf of another, then it is necessary for the agent or holder of the power of attorney to produce current, written evidence of their authority to act. **Failure to do so may render the document to be of no effect.**

All of the holders of the petroleum tenure **MUST** execute the appointment of agent or the power of attorney for the appointment or power of attorney to be effective. A company signing an appointment of agent or power of attorney must do so in accordance with the corporation law and/or the articles of association of the company (as can be disclosed by an ASIC search).

- A petroleum tenure holder may transfer a petroleum well in the area of the tenure to the holder of a geothermal exploration permit or a mining tenement if –
  - (a) The well is in the area of the permit or tenement; and
  - (b) A notice in the approved form and the transfer fee prescribed under the relevant regulation has been lodged with the Department.
  
- The tenure holder must return this Notification Form to the department with the signed transfer authority of the holder of the geothermal exploration permit or mining tenement to which the petroleum well applies.
  
- A “mining tenement” has that definition as contained in Schedule 2 of the *Mineral Resources Act 1989*. The *Mineral Resources Act 1989* defines a “mining tenement” as a prospecting permit, mining claim, exploration permit, mineral development licence or mining lease under that Act.
