Important information on completing this application form

- This application form is intended for an individual, corporation or partnership applying for a Licence to Manufacture explosives in Queensland at an established factory facility OR at or near the place where the explosives are to be used (refer S27, Explosives Regulation 2017).
- A **corporation** is a *registered company, association or club, co-operative trading society or government agency*.
- A **listed corporation** means a body corporate that is included in an official list of a prescribed financial market. The term “prescribed financial market” is defined as meaning “a financial market that is prescribed by regulations made for the purpose of this definition”. Each of the following financial markets are prescribed as a prescribed financial market in section 1.0.02A of the Corporations Regulation 2001:
 - (a) Asia Pacific Exchange Limited;
 - (b) ASX Limited;
 - (c) Chi-X Australia Pty Ltd;
 - (d) National Stock Exchange of Australia Limited;
 - (e) SIM Venture Securities Exchange Ltd.
- A **partnership** is the relation which subsists between persons carrying on a business in common with a view to profit. This includes a *limited liability partnership, an incorporated limited liability partnership or traditional partnership* (often referred to as ‘firm’ which doesn’t include incorporation or limited liability).
- A **Licence to Manufacture (Factory)** - authorises the holder of the authority to;
 - a) manufacture at the place stated in the licence, the explosives stated in the licence;
 - b) possess explosives manufactured and explosives used in the manufacture of the explosives under the licence;
 - c) purchase explosives used in the manufacture of the explosive stated in the licence; and
 - d) store the explosives at the place as required under Part 8 of the Explosives Regulation 2017.
- A **Licence to Manufacture (Place of use)** - authorises the holder of the authority to;
 - a) manufacture at the place stated in the licence, the explosives stated in the licence;
 - b) possess explosives manufactured and explosives used in the manufacture of the explosives under the licence;
 - c) purchase explosives used in the manufacture of the explosive stated in the licence; and
 - d) store the explosives at the place as required under Part 8 of the Explosives Regulation 2017.
- Where documents are required to be certified, they must be a certified copy of the original document and be certified only by a lawyer, justice of the peace, notary public or commissioner for declarations.
- The information entered onto this form must be printed in blue or black ink.
- Each box in the relevant ‘**Required items**’ sections of this form must be completed.
- The application form must be; completed in full, signed and dated.
- Ensure the correct fee(s) is paid for the licence period applied for (refer [Information Bulletin No 37](#)).

REQUIRED ITEMS: (tick if provided or cross if not provided)

- Payment or proof of payment of licence fee for selected period.
- A report demonstrating that the manufacturing plant will operate at an acceptable level of risk and the storage facilities meet the requirements of nominated legislation, standards and codes of practice as appropriate.
- A plan of the site drawn to scale detailing all buildings, mounds, works, magazines, stores, plant and equipment existing or proposed on the site or connected with the site, and the locations and quantities where explosives, ingredients, dangerous goods and combustible liquids will be kept; and the maximum number of persons to be employed in each building or room.
- A copy of the safety and security management system, including risk assessments, security plan, emergency response plan, procedures and controls, to a standard acceptable to the Chief Inspector of Explosives (refer Section 46A to 46D & Schedule 3 of Explosives Regulation 2017), **unless you are a one person operation**.
- Demonstration of SSAN compliance requirements including a completed SSAN security plan (refer [Information Bulletin 52](#), [Information Bulletin 53](#) and [Information Bulletin 56](#)) (where applicable).

Corporations only (does not include government agencies):

- A certified copy of the current Certificate of Incorporation.
- For registered companies, an ASIC extract that lists the current officeholders and persons having interest in the corporation. For co-operative trading societies, clubs or associations, a copy of the annual return to the Office of Fair Trading or any other official documentation that provides a list of current officeholders.

Listed corporations only:

- Listed corporations must nominate a director or employee of the corporation as a responsible person for matters relating to explosives. This person must hold a security clearance. Refer [E114 – nominated responsible person application form](#).

Partnerships only:

- A certified copy of the current *Certificate of Registration* of the business name.
- A certified copy of evidence of registration of the partnership under the *Partnership Act 1891* or a Statutory Declaration from each partner confirming: the name of the partnership; the name, address and contact details of each partner and the business in which the partnership is engaged.

Definitions

- Blasting explosives** means explosives used for blasting or producing a similar effect. Examples include ANFO (Ammonium Nitrate Fuel Oil), boosters, cartridges (plugs or sticks), detonators, detonating cord, precursors including ANE (Ammonium Nitrate Emulsion) and TNT.
- SSAN** means ammonium nitrate (AN) or a solid substance that consists of a mixture of AN and another substance of more than 45% AN by mass and not classified as Class 1 explosive. Examples include Ammonium Nitrate Prill (ANP) and Calcium Ammonium Nitrate (CAN).
- SSE** means security sensitive explosives which is a blasting explosive, propellant powder, firework (other than an unrestricted firework), pyrotechnic substance used in a firework or SSAN.

Privacy statement

Resources Safety & Health Queensland collects personal information from you, including your name, contact details, biometric information and information about your eligibility for an occupational authority. We collect this information to process your application for an authority and for administering authorities generally. The *Explosives Act 1999* allows or authorises us to collect this personal information. Your information may be reproduced on your authority, used in the administration of your authority and may be shared with other persons, including other Australian and New Zealand explosives regulators. This may include publishing authority details, other than your contact details, in an online register of authority holders. Your information may also be used to provide you with explosives safety updates, for statistical research, for auditing purposes, evaluation and reporting of our services. We will only use your information for these purposes. It will otherwise not be used or disclosed unless authorised or required by law. Your personal information will be handled in accordance with the *Information Privacy Act 2009*.

DECLARATION: I, as the individual applicant, authorised contact, director, partner or nominated responsible person, hereby make application and declare the information provided to be true and accurate to the best of my knowledge at this time. Should this application be successful, the applicant agrees to comply with the *Explosives Act 1999*, *Explosives Regulation 2017* and any conditions imposed.

- (If a listed corporation) I acknowledge that any authorities issued to the publicly listed corporation may be suspended or cancelled if there is not a responsible person for the corporation or the security clearance held by the responsible person has expired, or is cancelled, suspended or surrendered.
- (If a corporation) I acknowledge that any authorities issued to the corporation may be suspended or cancelled if the security clearances held by the directors of the corporation expire, or are cancelled, suspended or surrendered.
- (If a partnership) I acknowledge that any authorities issued to the partnership may be suspended or cancelled if the security clearances held by the partners expire, or are cancelled, suspended or surrendered.

The applicant acknowledges that;

- it is an offence under Section 188 of the *Explosives Regulation 2017* to provide false or misleading information in any application for an authority or renewal of an authority; and
- under section 15, 16 & 16A of the *Explosives Act 1999*, the Chief Inspector may make inquiries about a person's appropriateness to hold an authority; and
- under section 17 of the *Explosives Act 1999*, the Chief Inspector must refuse an application for a security sensitive authority unless the applicant holds a security clearance; and
- under section 23(1)(a) of the *Explosives Act 1999*, an authority issued based on incorrect or misleading information may be cancelled.
