This percentage figure is rounded up or down to the nearest whole figure.

\* This figure is a weighted average and is used so that the price is not overly distorted by very large and very small prices per ML. A value of \$0/ML indicates transfers for nil consideration e.g. by way of gift.

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## Transfer of Ownership - Land and Water

In addition to the trade of water separate from land, water allocations can also be traded together with land as a 'going concern'. The table below presents the number of transfers of water and land together along with the total volume of water entitlement transferred and the portion of the total available water those transfers represent in each ROP area.
