



Submission Form 2—Additional volume of water

Note that Submission Form 2 only applies to eligible entitlement holders – see Part 1 Schedule 1 of the draft water entitlement notice.

New section 89 of the draft water plan amendment provides an opportunity for eligible surface water entitlement holders to make a submission for an additional volume of water. New section 89B states that the department may decide the additional volume only if the 90th percentile of the recorded metered use is greater than the nominal volume for the authorisation under the draft water entitlement notice.

Note: 90th percentile means the value at which 90% of the values is equal to or below.

89B Additional volumes for particular authorisations if submission lodged under Act, s 72(2)

...(2) However, the chief executive may decide an additional volume only if satisfied the 90th percentile of the recorded volumes of water taken under the eligible converting authorisation in the water years during the HOU consideration period is greater than the nominal volume for the authorisation under the draft water entitlement notice.

Please contact the department on (07) 3330 4361 to obtain the department’s record on your 90th percentile value to consider your eligibility.

If you are not an eligible water user and you would like to comment on the proposed nominal volume of your water allocation you must use Submission Form 1.

An additional volume of water may be granted as either surface water or underground water provided that the water user also holds an underground water entitlement.

Properly made submissions must be made to the chief executive and received on or before 5 pm 18 January 2019. Email and internet submissions will also be accepted.

Assessment criteria

Please consult section 89C of the draft water plan for matters that may be considered in assessing a submission for additional volume of water. Examples include:

- access to available sources of water by the specific existing agricultural enterprise including from existing entitlements and other sources such as overland flow water or recycled water;
- demonstrated water use (including from other sources of water) for the specific existing agricultural enterprise
- any water efficiency practices used by the holder that relate to the demonstrated water use for the specific existing agricultural enterprise
- demonstration of the employment directly attributable to the specific existing agricultural enterprise
- past investment in irrigation infrastructure or water efficiency technology for use in the agricultural enterprise
- the total volume of water that can be effectively managed by the agricultural enterprise's infrastructure
- evidence of agricultural produce supply contracts, or part thereof, directly attributable to the specific existing agricultural enterprise
- if the holder is proposing to add the additional volume to an underground water entitlement, then:
 - the extent to which the agricultural enterprise is dependent on groundwater or any other source of water
 - the local availability of groundwater or the ability of the holder to access other sources of water for the agricultural enterprise.

An agricultural enterprise is defined in the draft plan as a standalone agricultural holding made up of contiguous land parcels used for the primary purpose of agricultural production.

All submissions will be referred to an independent referral panel for a recommendation to the chief executive. The chief executive, in finalising the draft water plan amendment will review and consider all information provided in properly made submissions.

How to complete this submission form

You may submit additional pages if necessary to support your submission. Submitters should first attempt to address the assessment criteria listed above and provide supporting documentation or evidence before including other additional information.

Checklist

- Have you completed all parts of Submission Form 2, where applicable?
- Have you demonstrated that your water use is directly related to the enterprise or part of the enterprise associated with the water supply scheme at time of draft plan amendment release?
- Have you described and demonstrated how the supporting information or evidence provided by you supports your submission for an additional volume of water?
- Have you clearly marked all additional sheets of paper with reference to the corresponding question number?
