Part 2: Submission form: Additional irrigable area assessment

If you are currently irrigating parcels of land that are not stated on your converting underground water licence/s, you may make a submission to have these non-licenced parcels considered as irrigable area used to calculate your final groundwater allocation/s. Submissions must address the criteria stated in section 84M of the new draft water plan amendment, which requires that the licence holder who makes the submission—

- Is the owner of the land which is requested for consideration as additional irrigable area, and
- Can demonstrate that the groundwater is being taken from the scheme using existing works on land attached to a water licence being converted in this draft plan amendment, and
- Can demonstrate that the groundwater was conveyed to the land by way of a pipeline or channel
- Can demonstrate that the land is not already accounted for in the preliminary irrigable area
- Can demonstrate that the land has been irrigated during the period of 1 July 2007 to 30 June 2018

Properly made submissions must be made to the chief executive and received on or before 5 pm 1 October 2019. Email and internet submissions will also be accepted.

All submissions will be treated as confidential where possible. However, submissions may be viewed by other parties under provisions in the *Right to Information Act 2009*.
