This application form is intended for the organiser of an Arms Fair to apply for a Permit to Store Explosives in Queensland (refer Section 30, Explosives Regulation 2017). This permit will allow permitted ammunition to be kept and sold at an approved Arms Fair held at a nominated place by a licensed or authorised seller of permitted ammunition operating under the control of the Arms Fair organiser.

Permitted Ammunition is small arms ammunition, 19 mm calibre maximum, and collectors' ammunition that is not filled with high explosive or not fitted with a live fuze.
