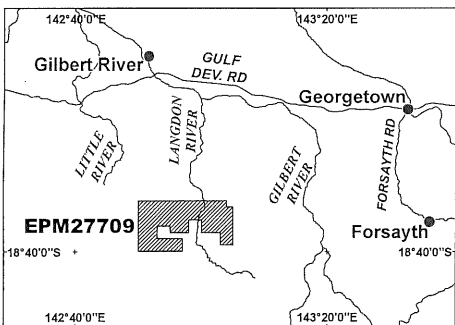


# NOTICE OF PROPOSED GRANT OF EXPLORATION PERMITS FOR MINERALS

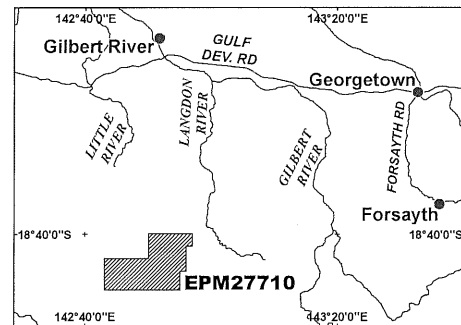
## NATIVE TITLE ACT 1993 (CTH) SECTION 29

The Queensland Minister for Natural Resources, Mines and Energy, PO Box 15216, City East, Queensland, 4002, hereby gives notice in accordance with s29 of the *Native Title Act 1993* (Cth) of the proposed grant of Exploration Permits for Minerals (EPM) 27709, EPM27710, EPM27711, EPM27712 and EPM27713 shown below under the *Mineral Resources Act 1989* (Qld).

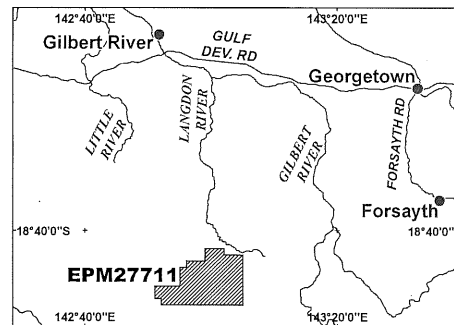
Exploration Permit 27709 sought by Evolution Mining (Connors ARC) Pty Ltd, ACN 625 735 846, over an area of 89 sub-blocks (289 km<sup>2</sup>), centred approximately 70 km South West of Georgetown, in the localities of the Croydon Shire Council and Etheridge Shire Council.



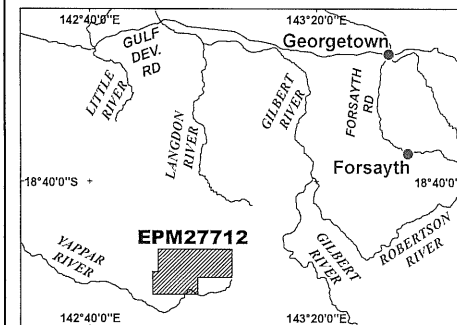
Exploration Permit 27710 sought by Evolution Mining (Connors ARC) Pty Ltd, ACN 625 735 846, over an area of 88 sub-blocks (285 km<sup>2</sup>), centred approximately 90 km South West of Georgetown, in the localities of the Croydon Shire Council and Etheridge Shire Council.



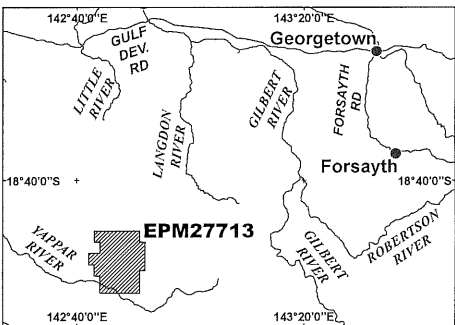
Exploration Permit 27711 sought by Evolution Mining (Connors ARC) Pty Ltd, ACN 625 735 846, over an area of 89 sub-blocks (288 km<sup>2</sup>), centred approximately 82 km South West of Georgetown, in the localities of the Croydon Shire Council and Etheridge Shire Council.



Exploration Permit 27712 sought by Evolution Mining (Connors ARC) Pty Ltd, ACN 625 735 846, over an area of 90 sub-blocks (291 km<sup>2</sup>), centred approximately 92 km South West of Georgetown, in the localities of the Croydon Shire Council and Etheridge Shire Council.



Exploration Permit 27713 sought by Evolution Mining (Connors ARC) Pty Ltd, ACN 625 735 846, over an area of 90 sub-blocks (292 km<sup>2</sup>), centred approximately 105 km South West of Georgetown, in the locality of the Croydon Shire Council.



**Nature of Act(s):** The grant of the Exploration Permits for Minerals under the *Mineral Resources Act 1989* (Qld), authorises the holder to explore for minerals for a term not exceeding five (5) years with the possibility of renewal for a term not exceeding five (5) years. It is proposed to grant the Exploration Permits for Minerals subject to the *Mineral Resources Act 1989* (Qld) and the Native Title Protection Conditions.

**Name and address of person doing acts:** It is proposed that the Exploration Permits for Minerals be granted subject to the provisions of the *Mineral Resources Act 1989* (Qld) by the Queensland Minister for Natural Resources, Mines and Energy, PO Box 15216, City East, Queensland, 4002.

**Native Title Parties:** Any person who is, or becomes a "native title party" within the meaning of the *Native Title Act 1993* (Cth) is entitled to the negotiation and/or procedural rights provided in Part 2, Division 3, Subdivision P of the *Native Title Act 1993* (Cth).

**Expedited Procedure:** The State of Queensland considers the grant of the Exploration Permits for Minerals to which this notice applies is an act attracting the Expedited Procedure. Each individual Exploration Permit for Minerals may be granted unless, within a period of four (4) months after the Notification Day a native title party lodges an objection in respect of the individual Exploration Permit for Minerals with the National Native Title Tribunal against the inclusion of the statement that the State considers the grant of that Exploration Permit for Minerals is a future act attracting the Expedited Procedure.
