NOTICE OF INTENTION TO CONVERT A PETROLEUM WELL TO A WATER OBSERVATION BORE OR A WATER SUPPLY BORE

- This information sheet is a summary only. Please refer to the *Petroleum and Gas (Production and Safety) Act 2004*, the *Petroleum Act 1923* and the associated Regulations, for further information.
- A petroleum well cannot be converted to a water observation bore or a water supply bore unless a well completion report for the well has been lodged.
- The petroleum tenure holder must comply with the requirements, prescribed under the Petroleum and Gas (General Provisions) Regulation 2017 for converting the petroleum well to a water observation bore or water supply bore.
- A drill log form must be lodged with the chief executive within 60 business days of the commencement of the conversion of the petroleum well to a water observation bore or water supply bore. A drill log form means the form, of that name, published on the department's website at www.business.qld.gov.au/industries.
