Mr Mills worked closely with all stakeholders from government to advance Kirriri and was instrumental in assisting with the progression of a number of land dealings and projects in partnership with DNRM and other agencies. Giving the gift of flowers demonstrated the State's respect for Mr Mills to his family and community, and showed respect for the associated Aboriginal cultural practices and decision making processes. The State continues to have a number of significant on-going land-related programs and projects on Kirriri, as demonstrated by the recent media release from Minister Pitt about "More housing options on Hammond Island". Continuing to build and maintain this relationship with Kaurareg people and the Kirriri community is essential.	Not applicable
