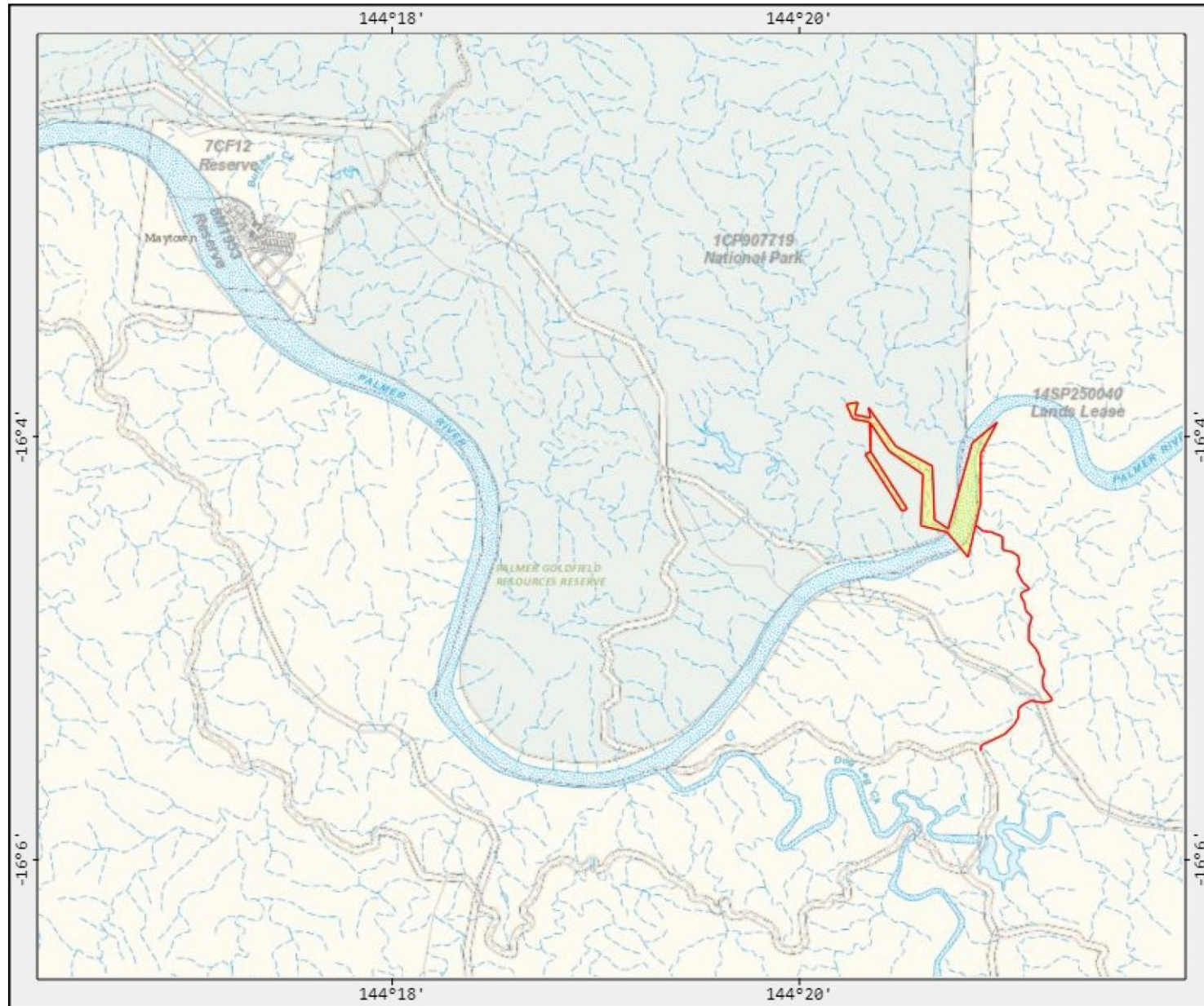

**Permit Term Justification:**

Application is made for a term of 20 years. This lease forms part of an already active project. The term applied for allows for completion of works on other permits prior to commencement on this permit. Approximately 10 - 12 years of production on a part-time basis will be required and a further 3 years of rehabilitation to the satisfaction of DES.

**Permit Size and Shape (attach maps):**

An area of approximately 32.69 hectares is applied for. See attached maps.

**Minerals Sought:**

Gold

**Other Purposes Sought:**

Processing Plant

**Mineralisation/Tonnes/Banked cubic metres (BCM); Grade:**

We estimate that there is approximately 250,000 bcm within the alluvial channels in the application area. The gold grade typically runs to 0.3g/t

**Mining Methodology:**

This is a 2 – 3 man operation with contractors engaged as required. Mining is semi-mobile with a plant site. Material will be removed from the bed by excavator and carried by truck to the plant site for processing. Alluvial processing is by way of wet, gravity fed trommel plant, 2 sluice

boxes, a feeder bin. The alternate plant is a shaker screen with feeder bin and one sluice box.

The sand tailings will be fed back into the creek bed, covered by rock tailings for stabilisation.

**Minimum Mining Rate (tonnes or BCM per hrs/days/years):**

200t per day for 60 days per season

**Infrastructure:**

No infrastructure will be located on this lease. The camp is located at the Butchers Creek site.

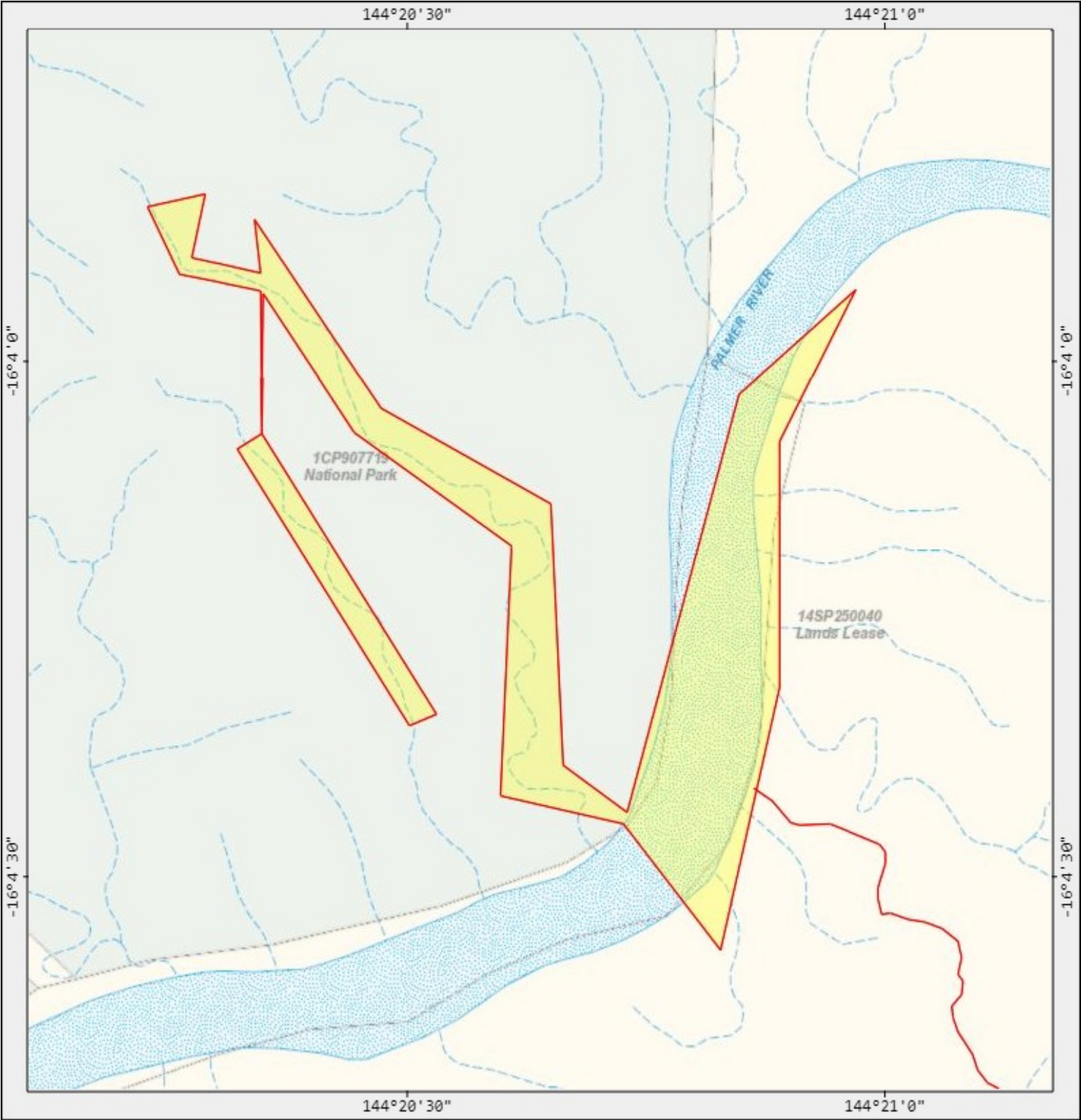

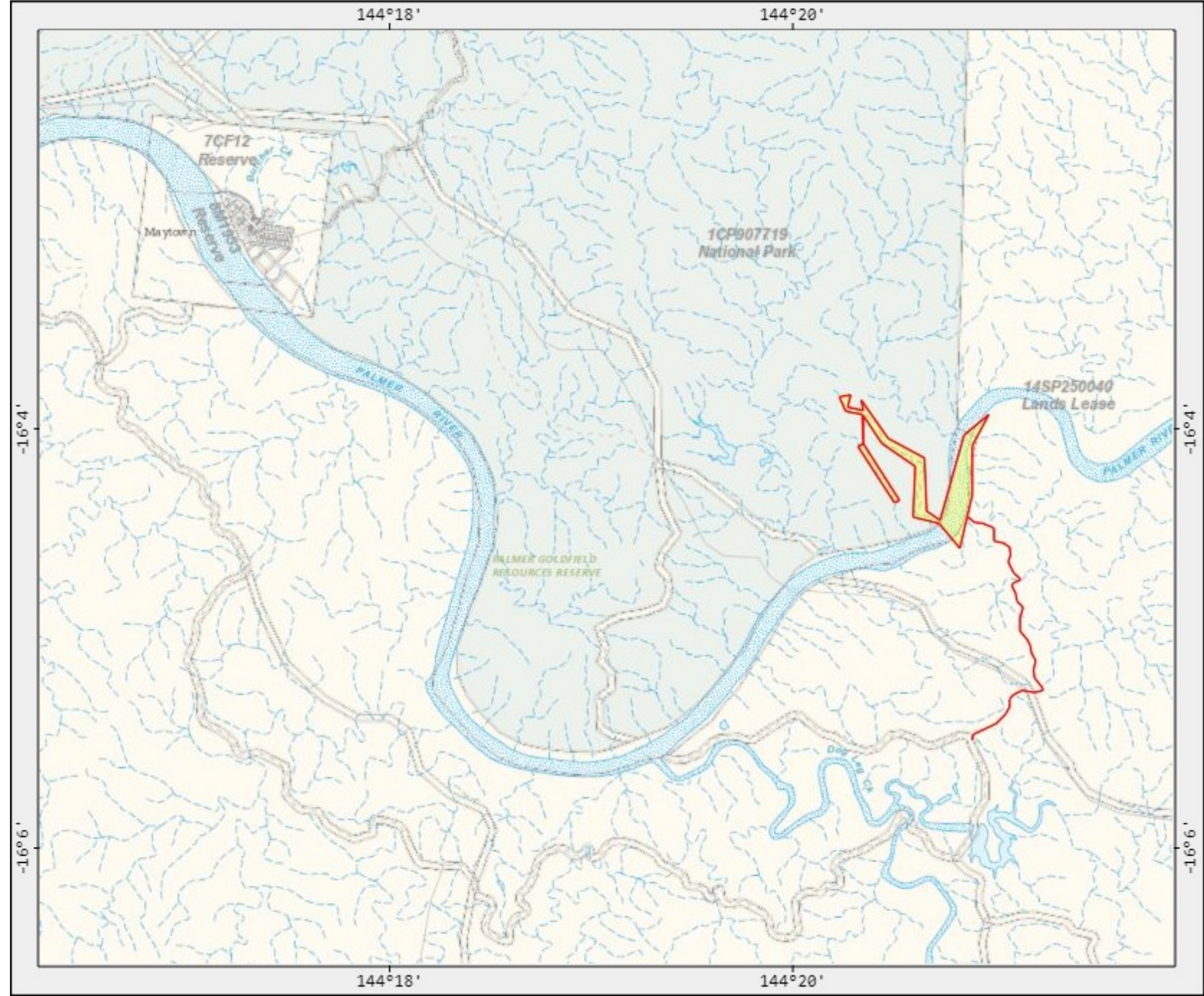

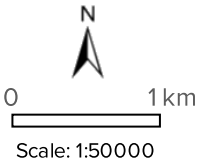

#### *Criteria for single integrated application*

The mining activities will be carried out under the day to day management of Jack Fitzgerald. The permit is for alluvial gold mining and operationally interrelated with the other mining leases on this environmental authority. All activities are located on the same property and within a couple of hours travel from each other.

### **Section 22 – Environmental values**

A review of the map for environmentally sensitive areas and strategic environmental areas shows no significant areas of concern within the area of the mining lease, however, it does sit within the Palmer Goldfield Mining Landscape heritage listing.

Environmental values such as water, groundwater, wetlands, air, acoustic and waste are not going to be significantly affected by the addition of this application to the existing environmental authority. This area is an alluvial mining field with a number of existing mining operations within the neighbouring properties. Land use will be affected in a minor way throughout seasonal mining operations. 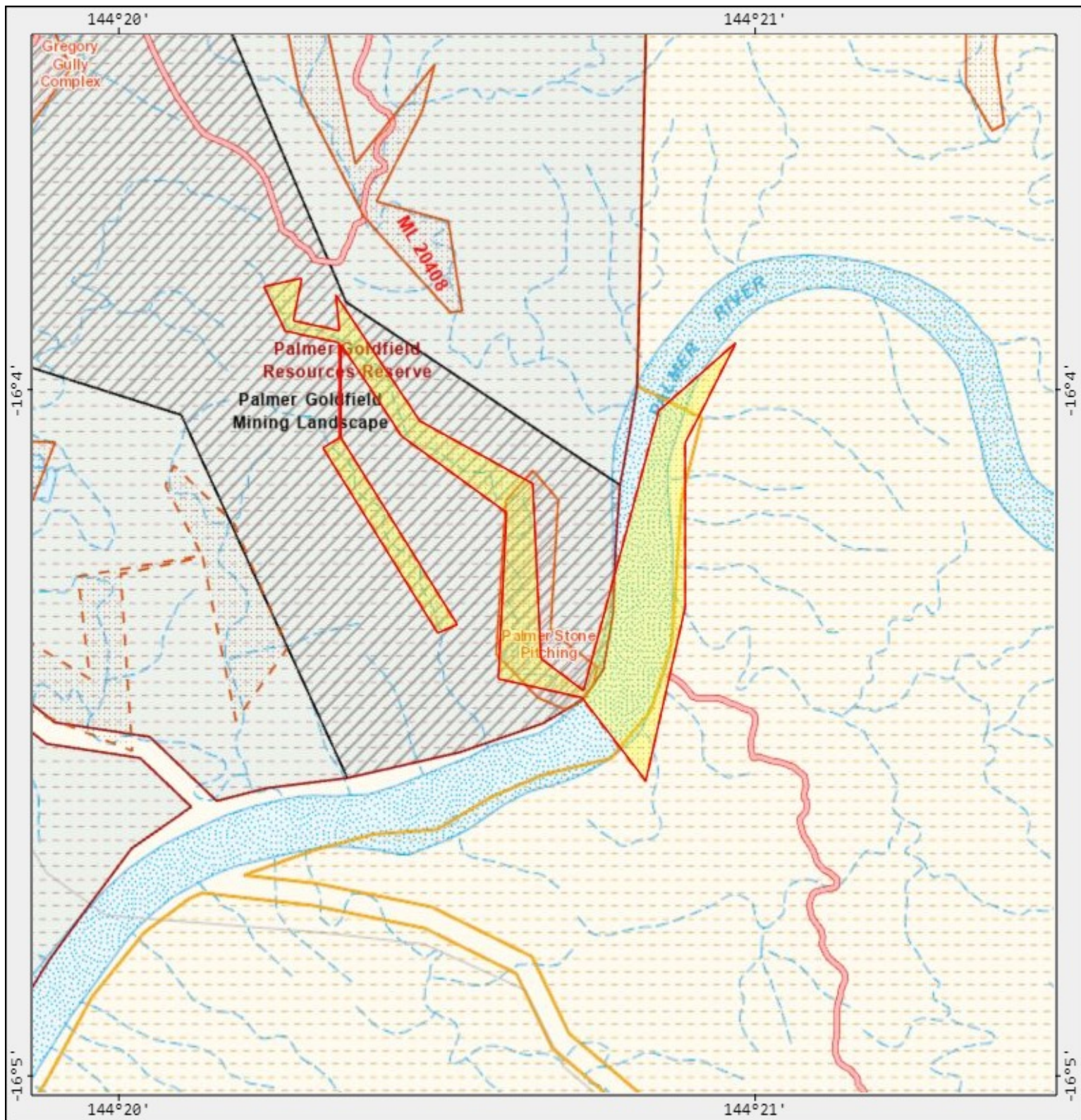
